The answer is NOT in the text. You will need to **THINK** about what you already know, what the author tells you in the text, and how it fits together...

The answer is NOT in the text. You can even answer the question without reading the story. You use your ideas, experiences, and opinions. **They text** will help you form your ideas/answers/opinions...
